The OWSI water filtration and chlorination project broke ground right around the first of this year. The majority of the underground utilities are installed and the building is being constructed. The filter vessels were placed before the building walls were installed due to their size.

These filters are designed to be capable of treating 600 gallons of water per minute.



The building is going up rapidly and will have siding installed this week.
